Summary of our Guest Privacy and Safety/Security Policies for our Economy and Select Service Hotels

Every guest must present satisfactory state-issued picture identification upon registration and supply all other information requested. (Military ID alone is not sufficient for this.) The clerk on duty may require others occupying the room to identify themselves and show ID as well.

A room may be rented only to an individual who will actually be occupying the room, and who can be held responsible and accountable for all others occupying it. Everyone who rents a room must meet minimum age requirements.

The pool and any other exercise facilities will generally be open until 8:00pm, and will thereafter remain open, if at all, at the sole discretion of the clerk on duty. For the safety and good of all who use those facilities, please obey the posted rules in each.

Beechmont Hotels supports Nan's Law (<http://www.nanslaw.org/>). Every employee of Beechmont Hotels who has access to guestroom keys must satisfactorily pass a complete public records background check prior to hire and every year thereafter. Persons with a history of arrests, drug use; or nuisance, stalking or sex offenses, are neither invited nor welcome to apply for employment with any Beechmont hotel.

During day and early evening hours, the back doors are operable with a room key and may be used by guests. At night, the back door will remain secured and alarmed, and all who enter the building must do so through the front door. ALL COMMON AREAS ARE UNDER VIDEO SURVEILLANCE. We keep the videos and DVDs indefinitely.

LOITERING (even if inside a vehicle), OR WANDERING ABOUT THE PARKING LOT OR COMMON AREAS TO NO GOOD PURPOSE, IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN, AND WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL AND PERMANENT BANISHMENT FROM THE PROPERTY. IF YOU ARE A REGISTERED GUEST AND ARE REMOVED FOR THIS CAUSE, YOU WILL NOT BE REFUNDED. For the safety of all, please report to the front desk anyone you see loitering upon or wandering about the property of this hotel.

We freely share any guest registration information with local, civilian law enforcement authorities upon their request for any bona-fide law enforcement purpose: generally, any public peace officer need only show us a badge and give us a name. (If they give us yours, and you are the sort of individual for whom that could be a problem, perhaps you should seek accommodations elsewhere. We do not welcome the criminal, drug or vice elements, whether local or traveling.) We share no other guest information with anyone outside the Beechmont organization without either a court order or by direction of a corporate officer (vice president or above). We keep our guest registration information on file for a minimum of one year.

Every peaceable guest has a right to a safe, quiet, private and comfortable place to stay during their time here. These and other rules are intended to enforce and support that right. *We would rather leave some rooms go unrented and lose the revenue on those rooms, than to rent them to people whose behavior would violate or infringe upon that right.* Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.
